#### • Reading Room / Library Facility at Bangalore South :

During the year reading room facility at Bangalore South opp: ITT Centre, #215, Subbarama Chetty Road, Netkallapa Circle, Bangalore was made operational, enabling the students and members from Bangalore South to make use of the facility and refer books. The same was inaugurated by an eminent personality Shri. Mathoor Krishnamoorthi, Director Bharathiya Vidya Bhavan, Bangalore. We feel very happy as many of our students are regularly making use of the facility.

#### • Installation of new elevator:

Considering the frequent breakdown of the old elevator, during the year committee has taken a decision to install a new elevator. Installation of new elevator from OTIS is in progress & the same will be completed by end of January 2012.

#### • Load Break Switch (LBS):

During the year, old transformer was removed and a new Load Break Switch was installed resulting in freeing up of space of about 200 sq.ft., which could be used for parking two wheelers or to develop a lawn and provide a facelift to the elevation of the Building.

#### • Additional Premises :

A Committee was formed with an intention to augment our efforts to identify a suitable location / premises to house the additional campus of the Bangalore branch to cater to the needs of ever increasing members and students.

The library is being used by 150 students a day on an average, which goes up to 250-300 students per day during the examinations.

The average number of members visiting the library per day is approximately 25. We have digitized the inventory of books at library, wherein members can know about the books and their availability. It provides information about usage of books and provides valuable information for regular sourcing of books. Ebooks of the ICAI are also made available.

During the year reading room facility at Bangalore South opp: ITT Centre, #215, Subbarama Chetty Road, Netkallapa Circle, Bangalore was made operational, enabling the students and members from Bangalore South to make use of the facility and refer books.




