• New Look To Branch Website:

With the growing importance of online presence, we have always dwelt upon providing important information to members through the website of the branch. During the year, we have revamped the presentation of information on the website and also ensured updation of information on a regular basis. The hits on the website has increased acknowledging the importance of website.

The monthly News Letter: Presentations of important Seminars, Workshops and Study Circle Meetings were updated, enabling the members and students to enrich their knowledge.

• Web Casting:

For the first time Bangalore Branch, as a part of e-initiative the entire Sub Regional CPE Conference – **"VIDVATH - Professional excellence"** was webcasted live for the benefit of members and students across the Globe and enabling any member or student to get updated sitting at any corner of the world. • Information KIOSK:

A Kiosk is being installed at the branch premises to enable the members and students to have a fair idea of the **FAQs**

• **E-payment:**

E-payment facility was extended to workshops, apart from conference and seminars. Many members have opted to register for workshops through e-mode.

• **Study Circle Meeting at South:**

Study circle meetings were conducted at South for the benefit of members who are residing or having offices at Bangalore South. The Study circle meetings were well attended.

• **Digital Library:**

We have digitized the inventory of books at library, wherein members can know about the books and their availability. It provides information about usage of books and provides valuable information for regular sourcing of books. Ebooks of the ICAI are also made available.

• **Teleconference:**

We are happy to note that our efforts to provide wide publicity for the teleconferencing sessions conducted by ICAI yielded results and many members noticed and resulted in increased participation.

• **Subjectwise Coaching:**

During the year the committee has put in earnest efforts in improving the coaching classes for CA Students and as initiative, in this regard Subjectwise coaching is introduced inviting eminent, expert & experienced faculty members. This facility was well received by the students.

• **Contribution to CA Benevolent Fund:**

Apart from encouraging the members to contribute to CA benevolent fund, the committee has taken a decision to contribute Rs. 1,21,125/- to CA Benevolent fund, out of surplus generated in the conference conducted during the year.

Administration

• **STAFF AND HR:**

For the smooth functioning of any organization, efficient staff members with commitment are essential. Keeping this aspect in view, we have involved all staff members in all the activities. In July a Staff Training Programme to improve their overall performance was conducted and a picnic was also being organized in September to strengthen the bondage among them and paved way for better coordination for the successful conduct of programmes and activities.

• **INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT:**

As the days go by, the Branch is growing with all its activities for the members, students and society at large. As such we have to cater to the needs of the increasing number of students and members for which we need to have proper infrastructure facilities.

Hence, as an initiative for the development of Infrastructure, the following facilities are being improved upon.

• **Reading Room / Library Facility at Bangalore South :**

During the year reading room facility at Bangalore South opp: ITT Centre, #215, Subbarama Chetty Road, Netkallapa Circle, Bangalore was made operational, enabling the students and members from Bangalore South to make use of the facility and refer books. The same was inaugurated by an eminent personality Shri. Mathoor Krishnamoorthi, Director Bharathiya Vidya Bhavan, Bangalore. We feel very happy as many of our students are regularly making use of the facility.

• **Installation of new elevator:**

Considering the frequent breakdown of the old elevator, during the year committee has taken a decision to install a new elevator. Installation of new elevator from OTIS is in progress & the same will be completed by end of January 2012.

• **Load Break Switch (LBS):**

During the year, old transformer was removed and a new Load Break Switch was installed resulting in freeing up of space of about 200 sq.ft., which could be used for parking two wheelers or to develop a lawn and provide a facelift to the elevation of the Building.

• **Additional Premises :**

A Committee was formed with an intention to augment our efforts to identify a suitable location / premises to house the additional campus of the Bangalore branch to cater to the needs of ever increasing members and students.

BANGALORE: Even as India is poised to converge with the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) held talks with a delegation from Japan regarding the same at the Indo-Japan IFRS Dialogue here on Wednesday. India has agreed to adopt IFRS by this year-end.

CAG. Ramaswamy, president, ICAI, said both India and Japan were moving towards the implementation of convergence with IFRS. Both countries realise that they have commonality of issues on the convergence with the IFRS, he said. India and Japan have established a joint working group on issues relating to the application of convergence with the IFRS.

Exchange of views

During the dialogue, views were exchanged on how to establish a cooperative relationship between India and Japan in the field of human resource, exchanges, information technology and education among others, and also on how to promote the profession's role, responsibilities and achievements in advancing the interests of the accountancy profession.

NO DIFFERENCES, WILL ATTEND LOKPAL MEET: HEGDE | P3

I have no differences of opinion with Hazare: Hegde

Lokayukta Santosh Hegde on Saturday brushed off rumours that he is planning to leave the Anna Hazare Bill draft panel. Earlier, at a function organised by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, Hegde had said that, due to prior engagements, he will not be able to attend the draft committee meeting. But, after seeing news reports of him not in favour of Anna Hazare, Hegde postponed his other engagements and decided to attend the meeting.


"I am pained by the press statement saying I am not attending the Lokpal Bill Draft Committee meeting due to differences with Anna Hazare and his hunger strike. This is wholly incorrect. To prove the point, I will skip the programme scheduled in Mangalore so that I could be a part of the draft committee meeting to be held on Tuesday in New Delhi. I have no differences of opinion with Anna Hazare. I will stand by Anna Hazare in his endeavours against corruption," he said. "There is no question of me quitting the panel in the wake of differences between citizen representatives and the government," he said.

There are ongoing debates about the bringing the prime minister under the Lokpal's purview. "The prime minister has 5% share in corruption in the country. Investing agencies are not doing well. There is a need to strengthen such institutions through the bill," he said.


On the second Sayragrahi decision by Hazare, Hegde said people like Hazare should travel across the nation and entice the youth to fight corruption. "There is lack of political will to fight corruption at grassroots. For the same reason, the benefits of development schemes are not reaching villages," he added.
