Quiz contest:

- ★ There can be a maximum of 5 teams each team consisting of two students.
- * If there are more participants the 5 teams have to be selected by a process of Elimination. Written text (Aptitude) will be conducted for the process of elimination.
- * The Quiz contest will be conducted by a professional quiz master.
- ★ Quiz contest will have Eight Rounds covering the following areas:
- * Accounting, Auditing, Corporate Laws, Taxation, Direct Tax, Indirect Tax, Costing / Management Accounting, Financial Management, Information technology, Economics, General Awareness, Additionally there will be a rapid Fire Round, Audio Visual Rounds etc.
