Brief on AS-19 Lease

Lease is an agreement between parties, viz. lessor (owner of the asset) and lessee (another party) in which the former party gives the right to use his asset for an agreed period of time in return of lease rents.

There are two types of leases for accounting purpose. They are:

- 1. Finance Lease
- 2. Operating Lease

1. Finance Lease:

It is a lease inn which all significant risks and rewards are transferred from lessor to lessee except ownership.

Normally the following situations lead a lease to be financial lease:

- i. At the end of the lease term, ownership of assets will be transferred to lessee
- ii. Lessee has an option to purchase leased asset at the end of the lease term at a price lower than the fair market value of Assets
- iii. When lease term cover substantial part of useful life of assets
- iv. When present value of a minimum lease payment is equal to or substantially equal to fair market value of assets at inception of lease. (Here substantially equal means 90% or more)
- v. Asset is of specialized nature and it can not be used by a person other than lessee without major modification

2. Operating Lease

Operating Lease means other than finance lease i.e. in which all significant risks & rewards are not transferred from lessor to lessee.

Who is entitled to claim Depreciation under finance lease and operating lease as per Companies Act, 2013 and Income Tax Act 1961?

Lease	Companies Act, 2013	Income Tax Act, 1961
Finance Lease	Lessee	Lessor
Operating Lease	Lessor	Lessor

As per section 32 of Income tax Act, 1961, depreciation is allowed only to the owner of the property. Therefore depreciation is allowed only to lessor.

7. Guidelines for the contest

It is of the view that by participating in the contest, students will get motivated to study various topics in greater detail and thereby it will enhance their knowledge and improve their overall performance, apart from honing their communication skills.

General Guidelines

- 1. All contests will be in medium of English
- 2. The dress code will be formal
- 3. Students to carry the identity card of the respective school /college
- 4. The decision of the judges as regards result of competitions will be final

Quiz contest

- 1. Only team entries are eligible
- 2. A team shall consist maximum 2 persons
- 3. The Quiz contest will be conducted by a professional quiz master
- 4. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments
- 5. Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after registration
- 6. The quiz is conducted in three rounds and a surprise round is conducted in case of tie in final round

Elocution contest

- 1. Each contestant has to submit the chosen topic on which he/she will be speaking an hour before the start of the contest.
- 2. Each contestant will be given 8 minutes time a warning bell will ring at the end of the 6th minute, signaling the contestant to conclude the discussion in another two minutes.
- **3.** A three-member panel of judges will evaluate the performance of the contestants. Decision of the judges will be final
- **4.** Medium of Elocution contest would be English.
- 5. The speaker is allowed to memorize their speech and not allowed to use any note to read (ppt. is not allowed)

Essay writing contest

- 1. Essay submission shall be in English
- 2. Each contestant is allowed to submit essay on any one topic.
- 3. The Essay shall not be more than 1500 words long.
- 4. Allotted time is one hour.
- 5. Essay Submission shall not be directly copied from any text books or online information. References may be quoted where relevant.
- 6. At the time of writing essay mobile phones or any kind of books, electronic devices are not allowed.

8. Criteria for Evaluation

Quiz contest

First round of Quiz

- 1. First round of guiz is the examination and elimination round
- 2. Teams will be provided with 15 questions
- 3. The questions would be related in the areas of accounting, finance, commerce/business and general awareness
- 4. The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, True / False statement, Specific-answer question etc
- 5. Five teams are selected for final round
- 6. Teams selected for the final rounds will be allowed to give themselves an appropriate name related to the competition by which they may want to be known

Final round of Quiz

- 1. Five teams selected in first round are eligible for final round
- 2. Final quiz has 3 rounds of evaluation
 - Round 1 : Stage Round
 - Round 2 : Rapid fire round
 - Round 3: Audio-Visual round
- 3. Round 1 Stage Round
 - Each team would be asked 4 questions each. (Objective questions with options)
 - 10 marks for correct answer
 - If a team cannot answer the question, they can pass the question & then the question would be forwarded to the next team
 - Answering time is only 30 seconds
 - Team discussion is allowed
- 4. Round 2: Rapid fire round
 - Each team will be asked 10 questions one after another in one minutes time
 - 10 marks for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong answer
 - Answering time is only 3 seconds
 - Team discussion is allowed
 - If a team cannot answer the question, they can say pass for the next question. The question will not be forwarded to the next team.
- 5. Round 3: Audio-Visual Round
 - Teams will be shown clips and will have to answer
 - 10 marks for the correct answer
 - Each Team would be asked 2 audio-visual questions. (1 slide in each round)
 - Answering time is only 30 seconds.
 - No passing to the next team
